- On [REDACTED] the five team members boarded the OV Sagittarius and launched into their month long orbit at [REDACTED]. Spirits high.
- [REDACTED] were spent rather idly. [REDACTED] repeatedly picked fights with [REDACTED] who refused to engage with him, only angering the man further.
